We're seeing this happen RIGHT NOW on the national level as Congress is poised to pass a historic investment in child care and paid leave.

We're also seeing it in the newly expanded Child Tax Credit, which began to be delivered in monthly installments to parents this month. We have been fighting together for over a decade to ensure parents have more of the financial resources and support that they need—and this is the first step to getting us there! Our movement—fueled by your passion, stories, and nonstop fight for change—has gained Oregon national media attention. Oregon families and providers were recently featured in a
