On Saturday, October 23, local moms and caregivers showed up at Rep. Kurt Schrader's offices in Salem and Oregon City to remind him that a future without child care, paid leave, and support for our families is too scary to imagine. For too long, Rep. Kurt Schrader has obstructed progress on the Build Back Better Act while our families have struggled through a pandemic.

We made it clear to Rep. Schrader that we need policies that truly support *all* families. It brought all of us real joy to be back together with you and your families (in a COVID safe way) and we can't wait to do it again!

Our action came right in the nick of time, though. President Biden released the <u>Build Back Better Act's framework</u> this week and it includes a huge step towards our vision of a universal child care system, including historic investments in child care and universal preschool. \$400 billion is more than America has EVER spent on child care, and gives us reason to have hope about finally being able to develop the system we need, one that supports parents, providers, and our kids.

BUT, as of now, it also excludes a national paid family and medical leave program! Even though we've already passed 12 weeks of paid leave in Oregon you can count on us to keep fighting for all families across the country to have this same essential care support. Stay tuned for ways to make your voice heard for the strongest Build Back Better possible!

It's been a rollercoaster of a week and I'm celebrating each and every one of you. I know it's not easy to be a mom or caregiver and also still *care* about all of this stuff. But you do.
