We're fully in campaign mode now, with just 7 days left until the November 8 midterm election. With exceptionally close races and all of our rights and progress on the line, we've been giving it all we've got. Here's what you did just last month:

YOUR WINS

- We're sending a mailer in support of Tina Kotek to approximately 165,000 voters this
 week who we know are likely to support care champions. This is (by far!) our biggest
 mailing ever, and it was made possible by all your generous support this year!
- We've made 583 phone calls and sent 21,233 text messages in support of our endorsed candidates (and counting). You can join us as a volunteer here: motherpac.org/volunteer
- We're hosting 11 ballot clinics at two locations in the Salem/Woodburn area to help turnout Spanish-speaking voters. This work is being led by our Organizing Director, Elisa Andrade; our Regional Organizer, Francisca Aparicio; and our Bilingual

- Communications Manager, Francisca Garfia. All of these staff positions were made possible by your generous support!
- This month 8 supporters have hosted 3 house parties raising critical funds for Family Forward Action and The Mother PAC! Their funds will go directly to helping us expand our voter outreach work.
